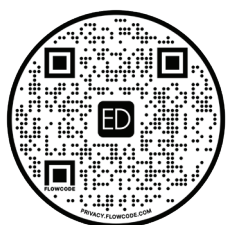

STAY PRESSED
A Bengal stripe (far right) is a classic pattern of evenly spaced verticals in contrasting colors, often alternating with white. Block-printed stripes feature subtly overlapping strips of color.

GOOD MEASURE
Woven stripes (top left) use colored yarns to create durable, dimensional, and inherently structured patterns, while sawtooth stripes—also known as zigzags or jagged edges—resemble the blade of a saw (top right). Cabana stripes, characterized by broad and vibrant color pairings, are derived from beachfront lounge tents popular at midcentury resorts.
